## I. Preamble

3. *The Contractual Parties* declare with this *Agreement* their readiness to participate in and mutually assist with their mutual cooperation.

## II. Subject of the Agreement

The subject of this *Agreement* is the agreement by the *Contractual Parties* on the form of their cooperation which by appropriate means and in appropriate amounts will enable the development of the collaboration of the *Contractual Parties*.

## III. Forms of Cooperation

1. Cooperation of the *Contractual Parties* which is the subject of this *Agreement* can be realized in the areas of education. Specific initiatives shall be discussed and documented in electronic or written form.
2. Cooperation between the *Contractual Parties* can be carried out in the form of:

- a) Arrangement and securing of the exchange of students of the **Contractual Parties**; (note: hereby a separate written agreement can be prepared before the start of the exchange i. e. specific number of students to be exchanged, specific faculties or departments involved etc.)
- b) Implementation of mutual short-term and long-term stays for students, lecturers, scientific as well as non-scientific personnel of the **Contractual Parties** (e.g. winter and summer schools, etc); including possible events, such as seminars, colloquia and symposia, including presentation of the work of students, lecturers and scientific personnel of the **Contractual Parties**;
- c) Other forms of cooperation to be decided by the **Contractual Parties** in written form.

#### IV. Realization of the Agreement

1. The creation and realization of each and every joint initiative shall be carried out further on the basis of a separate contract after agreement of **Contractual Parties** and in case of III. 2.c) which will be based on this **Agreement** and in accordance with the applicable laws and regulations.
2. Both **Contractual Parties** will work together to create the best environment for fulfilling this **Agreement** and for fulfilling specific agreements in the fields as stated in the subject of this **Agreement** and in other mutually advantageous activities.
3. The **Contractual Parties** have no financial liabilities under this Agreement to the second party. All activities arising from the areas of cooperation set out in **this Agreement** are subject to the availability of funding by each institution.

#### V. Final provisions

1. This **Agreement** comes into effect on the day of its signing by the authorized representatives of the **Contractual Parties** and any alterations and additions will be made with the mutual agreement of the **Contractual Parties** in the form of written additional agreements.
2. This **Agreement** is valid for a period of 3 years, starting from the date of signing the agreement. It is automatically extended for the same period on the same terms and conditions, unless one of the **Contractual Parties** wishes to terminate the **Agreement**. This can only be done by giving a written notice six months before the respective end of the **Agreement**. However, the end of the **Agreement** shall not affect any programs or projects that are then still in their execution.
3. This **Agreement** is prepared in 4 copies (2 languages: Ukrainian and English) of which two is held by Igor Sikorsky Kyiv Polytechnic Institute and two by OTH Amberg-Weiden

4. As a sign of endorsement of the above stated agreements which were decided upon freely, seriously and definitely, the authorized representatives of the **Contractual Parties** undersign this **Agreement**.
